Planting Trees for Future Generations

Dozens of energetic volunteers successfully planted more than two thousand shrubs and tree seedlings on the Lower Trent Trail on Saturday, April 30 and Sunday, May 1.

The habitat restoration activity is a partnership project between the City of Quinte West, Bata Development Corporation and the Friends of the Trail Inc.

The planting is being done on the trail section disturbed by the recent water main installation from Frankford to Batawa.

"This section is showing considerably more promise now and should become one of the most diverse areas along the trail once the growth matures, said Bill Gray, Chair for the Friends of the Trail."

The organization hopes to get the remainder of the trees in the ground this week and is expecting some Bata Development Corporation and Public School help with the small sections left to plant.
